
However, Cleopatra would have to use her feminine intuition and charm Caesar's plans to vex.

He was most surprised, as he did not expect such a lovely creature to greet!


She arrived in pomp and ceremony, how she Antony did charm!

First a traitorous Egyptian General had a very fatal lesson to learn;


And then Cleopatra's sister was killed on the steps of a temple where she from Psycho Chick's wrath did sojourn.

Cleopatra, even though dubbed a Psycho Chick, mainly by Roman propaganda,


Was a well loved and worshipped leader, her people could see through all the slander.

This time he knew he had to stay and married her according to Egyptian rite.


It was during their marriage that Psycho Cleo had child number four,
